## CURRICULUM

CGS is authorized to offer three International Baccalaureate programmes, ranging from the pre-school to the secondary level. At the secondary level, students follow the Greek National Curriculum delivered through the IB Middle Years Programme (IB MYP) and receive the qualification, "Apolytirio Gymnasiou". After Grade 10 (IB MYP5) students decide whether they will follow the National Curriculum of Senior High School ("Eniaio Lykeiou") leading to the high school diploma "Apolytiro Genikou Lykeiou" or undertake the International Baccalaureate Diploma Programme (IB DP), leading to the IB Diploma.
