Speaking & Listening Skills

By the end of the stage, the pupil is expected to:

- ✓ Understand main ideas and new topics using familiar language
- ✓ Use correct word order when asking questions or forming sentences
- ✓ Communicate using familiar vocabulary and sentences
- ✓ With encouragement contribute to class discussions
- ✓ Understand spoken instructions in the school environment and respond appropriately to them
- ✓ Organize and present ideas in brief oral presentations at a level of ability appropriate to grade level

Reading Skills

By the end of the stage, the pupil is expected to:

- ✓ Read and understand simple texts with guidance
- ✓ Comprehend the main ideas presented in simple texts
- ✓ Read aloud fluently
- ✓ Read with expression and appropriate pacing
- ✓ Draw on knowledge of letter- sound relationships when trying to read unknown words
- ✓ Answer comprehension questions related to known texts
- ✓ Attempt to retell a familiar story using appropriate vocabulary with guidance

Writing Skills

By the end of the stage, the pupil is expected to:

- ✓ Write simple statements to form short paragraphs and descriptions
- ✓ Use accurate word order in sentences
- ✓ Write common words accurately without copying
- ✓ Identify and correct simple errors with guidance
- ✓ Use simple grammatical structures in sentences
- ✓ Use correct punctuation when writing small paragraphs
- ✓ Use varied vocabulary in written texts
